#### Report Guidelines

The report must be submitted **within one month** of your attendance at the event and should be sent to your Doctoral Coordinator and the Graduate School. The Graduate School may then upload these reports onto the Graduate School website for our promotional purposes.

Blog:

- 500-800 words
- Offer a summary of the event and detail how the experience has benefited your research and personal development.
- Include at least one image and ensure your name, school and project title are given in the document.
